Obsolete Test Helicobacter pylori Breath Test



Helicobacter pylori Breath Test

Effective May 1st, 2019, St. Luke's Laboratory will no longer perform *H. pylori* Breath Sample testing.

The recommended testing alternative is *Helicobacter pylori* stool antigen testing. St. Luke's Laboratory utilizes a rapid lateral flow immunoassay.

Test Mnemonic: HPYLORIAGSTOOL Test Name: Helicobacter Pylori Ag, F

Specimen Type: 5 grams of liquid, semi-solid, or formed feces in a screw-capped container. Specimen should be refrigerated and transported within 72 hours. Samples can be frozen if greater than 72 hour transport time.

Samples will be rejected if received in transport media, preserved, very watery or on a swab.
